

What are my options if I am charged with a minor traffic violation?

You have three options:

1. Plead guilty and pay the fine, by mail or in person, without going to court. (A conviction will be entered on your driving record.)*

2. Plead not guilty and request a trial.*

*For options 1 and 2, follow the directions on your traffic ticket.

3. Request the Traffic Safety Program. You do not have to appear in court, and a conviction is not entered on your driving record if you:

a. sign the "Plea of Guilty" portion of your traffic ticket,

b. pay the \$75 fine and \$45 nonrefundable program fee,

c. attend the National Safety Council's Defensive Driving course offered by Parkland College,

d. avoid further violations during six months of court supervision.

What is the Traffic Safety Program?

The Traffic Safety Program, enacted by the Illinois Supreme Court and guided by the conference of Chief Judges, has been adopted by the Sixth Judicial Circuit Court. This program is intended to improve your driving skills, decrease the possibility of future traffic law violations, and reduce the chance you or someone else may be killed or injured in a traffic accident.

The Traffic Safety Program allows you to request court supervision and to avoid having minor traffic offenses appear as a conviction on your driving record.

What is the benefit of choosing the Traffic Safety Program?

If you successfully complete the Traffic Safety Program, the violation/ticket will be reported to the Secretary of State as "Court Supervision" and does not negatively impact your driving record.

Are you eligible for the Traffic Safety Program?

1. Yes No In the twelve (12) months preceding the date of this ticket, have you been charged with any moving violation anywhere in the U.S.?

2. Yes No In the four (4) years preceding the date of this ticket, have you taken a 4-hour Defensive Driving course, had a ticket amended to a "non-moving" violation, or been on Court Supervision anywhere in the U.S.?

3. Yes No Were you charged with driving twenty-one (21) miles or more over the posted speed limit?

4. Yes No Do you have a Commercial Driver's License (CDL)?

5. Yes No Was your ticket marked with **Court Appearance Required?**

If you answered **YES** to any of the questions above, you are **NOT** eligible to complete the Traffic Safety Program.

Yes No Are you under the age of twenty-one (21)? (if **YES**, you **must** complete the Traffic Safety Program within 120 days of your violation)

Yes No Are you under the age of eighteen (18)? (if **YES**, you **must** appear in court and complete the Traffic Safety Program within 120 days of your violation)

How does the program work?

If you choose the Traffic Safety Program option, you will receive four hours of defensive driving instruction, and you will agree to obey all traffic laws during six months of court supervision.

How do I show I have completed the Traffic Safety Program?

If you complete the program through Parkland College, Parkland will notify the court regarding your program completion and will present you with a certificate of completion for your personal records.

If you fail to complete the training or if you violate a traffic law during court supervision, a conviction will be entered against you and reported to the Secretary of State to be included on your driving record. Your program fee is forfeited.

How much time do I have?

1. The ticket, this form, and monies must be delivered to the court no later than ten (10) days before the court date written on the bottom of your ticket.

2. You are required to complete a National Safety Council defensive driving class no later than 120 days from the date of the violation.

3. The 180 days of court supervision begins on the day following the violation.

What if I do not live near this county?

If you are interested in taking the class at an alternate location, follow the registration instructions and mark "alternate location" under class options. You will receive further details and instructions by mail from Parkland College within 30 days. You are responsible for locating an alternate training site and submitting a National Safety Council DDC-4 completed class certificate to the circuit court within 120 days of your violation.

Registration Instructions

1. Sign the “Appearance, Plea of Guilty and Waiver” portion of your traffic ticket.
2. Complete and sign the “Plea of Guilty and Application for Court Supervision” portion of this form **if you are eligible**.
3. Complete the “Traffic Safety Program Registration” portion of this form.
4. Deliver your traffic ticket, this form, and the non-refundable \$120 fee in cash, bank certified check, money order, or personal check (payable to Circuit Clerk) to: Circuit Clerk, Traffic Division, 101 E. Main, Urbana, Illinois 61801. **Personal check should include your phone number and an additional \$1.25 processing fee.**
5. The ticket, form, and monies **must be delivered to the court no later than ten (10) days before the court date** written on the bottom of your ticket.
6. Delivery of the above may be made in person or by mail. Do not mail cash. If you paid \$75 cash to the officer as bond, only an additional \$45 must be paid.
7. The circuit clerk will forward your registration form to the Parkland College Traffic Safety Program office. **You will be notified by mail of your class assignment two weeks prior to the class date.**
8. If you need to change your class assignment, you must notify the Traffic Safety Program office, 217/353-2104, no later than 48 hours prior to the class start time. You will receive a new assignment upon payment of a \$10 rescheduling fee.
9. *If you fail to appear or if you are late for an assigned class, you must pay \$45 and request another class to complete the Traffic Safety Program.*

By signing this statement, I swear, or affirm, the following to be true:

1. I have NOT received a moving violation within twelve (12) months of this ticket that resulted in a conviction anywhere in the U.S.
2. I have not received a traffic ticket within forty-eight (48) months of this ticket that resulted in court supervision, had the ticket amended to a “non-moving” violation, or completed any Traffic Safety Program anywhere in the U.S.
3. I am not charged with speeding twenty-one (21) miles per hour or more over the speed limit on this ticket.
4. I do not have a CDL.
5. My ticket is not marked with a “must appear” offense.
6. I further understand that I DO PLEAD GUILTY to the charges on this ticket, WAIVE my right to a hearing by the court, and REQUEST court supervision.
7. I agree to pay \$40 for the Traffic Safety Program and \$5 to the Circuit Clerk for administrative costs.

I understand my driving record can be checked. If it indicates that I HAVE been charged with a traffic offense that resulted in any of the possibilities in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, MY PLEA OF GUILTY WILL BE ACCEPTED AND A CONVICTION ENTERED AGAINST ME AND REPORTED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO BE INCLUDED ON MY DRIVING RECORD.

I further understand, if I make an application for the Traffic Safety Program and I am not eligible, OR I fail to complete the Traffic Safety Program in a timely manner, OR I receive another traffic violation within my court supervision period, OR I fail to pay the appropriate fine and fee, THAT A CONVICTION WILL BE ENTERED AGAINST ME AND REPORTED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO BE INCLUDED ON MY DRIVING RECORD.
